

ORDINANCE NO. 604

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BEE CAVE, TEXAS, CANVASSING THE RETURNS AND DECLARING THE RESULTS OF THE MAY 2, 2026, JOINT GENERAL ELECTION FOR TWO (2) COUNCIL MEMBERS AND A MAYOR FOR FULL TERM.

WHEREAS, an election was held in the City of Bee Cave, Texas on May 2, 2026, for the purpose of electing two (2) Council Members and a Mayor for full terms.

WHEREAS, the City Council has reviewed and investigated all matters pertaining to this election, including the ordering, notices, election officers, holding and returns thereof; and

WHEREAS, the City Council hereby canvasses the returns of this election, at which there was submitted to all resident, qualified electors of the City for their action thereupon, the election of two (2) Council Members and a Mayor for full terms; and

WHEREAS, the City has diligently inquired into the poll lists and the official election returns which were duly and lawfully made to this City Council by the judges and clerks holding and conducting the election; the poll lists and the official election returns showing separately the votes cast in the election; and

WHEREAS, City Council members Kit Crumbley and Andrea Willott were unopposed candidates in their respective races; and

WHEREAS, from these returns, this City Council hereby finds that the votes described herein were cast in the election by voters who were resident, qualified electors of the City;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEE CAVE THAT:

SECTION 1. All of the above premises are hereby found to be true and correct legislative and factual findings of the City and are hereby approved and incorporated into the body of this Ordinance as if copied in their entirety.

SECTION 2. The City Council officially finds, determines, and declares that the election was duly and properly ordered, that proper legal notice of such election was duly given in the English language and the Spanish language, that proper election officers were duly appointed prior to the election, that the election was duly and legally held, that all resident, qualified electors of the City were permitted to vote at the election, and due returns of the results of the election had been made and delivered, and that the City of Bee Cave has duly canvassed such returns, all in accordance with the laws of the State of Texas and of the United States of America and the ordinance calling the election.

SECTION 3. The official canvass of the returns of the election reflects that the following candidates received the number of votes set opposite the candidate's name:




